There are two travel groups: Both groups will participate in the 11th International Conference June 25-28, 2018.

- **Group A:** Conference Only. **Depart** New York (JFK Airport) on Saturday, June 23, 1018 at 7:30 p.m. on Delta Airlines. Cost of \$3,650 includes conference registration, roundtrip airfare, ground transportation in Botswana, hotel double occupancy in Gaborone (single room is \$200 extra), breakfast, tea breaks during sessions, lunch, and evening receptions. **Return** arrival in New York on June 28, 2018 is 5:30 a.m.
