**CIMPAD Terms and Conditions**

**1. ATTENDEE RESPONSIBILITIES**

Attendees are responsible for their air travel to and from Angola. The main airport is Dr. António Agostinho Neto International Airport (NBJ). Airport transfers will be provided. Unless staying at the Venancio de Moura Diplomatic Academy (ADVM), conference registration also does not include hotel accommodations.

Attendees are required to report flight, hotel, and relevant health and safety information to CIMPAD in advance of travel to the host country.

**2. PASSPORTS, VISAS, AND TRAVEL PERMIT(S)**

All travel documents are the responsibility of the in-person attendee. A valid passport with at least 6 months validity after the date of entry into Angola, and at least one (1) blank page is required. You are responsible for checking with the appropriate consulates and respective authorities. A visa is not required for entry into Angola. To allow sufficient time to make in-country travel arrangements, please complete the registration process by May 20th, 2026 and the Health and Safety form by June 1, 2026.

Since January 1, 2007, all nationals (U.S. and foreign) are required to hold a valid passport to enter or re-enter the United States through airports and seaports. This passport requirement means that birth certificates and other government-issued IDs are no longer acceptable proof of citizenship. Note that our agents cannot be expected to know all documentation requirements for your trip. No refunds will be entertained for passengers who cannot embark on an aircraft due to incomplete documentation, such as a lack of passports or visas, or affidavits for minors traveling alone or with only one parent. Keep in mind that entry requirements may vary for U.S. citizens and non-U.S. citizens. Airport departure and entry fees/taxes are not always included in the airline ticket. This may be required to be paid at your visiting destinations.

**3. TRAVEL INSURANCE**

Travel insurance is highly recommended. Travel insurance is an optional / non-mandatory item. Such coverage may include trip cancellation, interruption, medical emergency, etc. You are responsible for selecting a travel insurance provider if you desire coverage for your trip. **4. PAYMENTS**

We accept online payment through debit or credit cards issued in the US and Canada. Please note that all prices are reflected in US dollars. The obligation for the client to us is the whole amount of the booking at the time of booking.

**5. NAME CHANGES**

Names on reservations must match the information included in your passport(s). You are responsible for providing us with your legal first and last names as they are shown on your passport. Once your reservation is processed, name changes are NOT allowed. It is the responsibility of the attendee to ensure the accuracy of information supplied.

## 6. CANCELLATIONS

A cancellation is defined as the voluntary termination of an entire trip. **You understand the conference package is completely non-refundable.** If you are unable to attend a scheduled tour program within the package, no refunds or partial refunds will be provided. If you miss a transfer due to unforeseen circumstances, no partial refunds or reimbursements will be provided.

## 7. RESPONSIBILITY

CIMPAD and Intraworld Travel, Inc are acting only as agents for the attendee with regard to transportation, the conference, pre, and post-conference excursions, and assumes no liability for injury, damage, loss, accident, delay or irregularity, which may be caused due to defect in any vehicle, acts of God, war, riots, or for any company or person involved in conveying the participant or in carrying out transport or during any conference activities. We cannot accept any responsibility for losses or additional expenses due to delay or changes in schedules, or other causes such as strikes. All such losses will be the responsibility of the participant. The right is reserved to make minor adjustments in the itinerary. CIMPAD is not responsible for any lost or damaged luggage before, during, or after the conference program. The right is reserved to decline, to accept, or to retain any passenger as a member of the conference program. The issuance of vouchers or tickets shall be deemed to be consent to the above conditions. All taxes, gratuities, and portage charges are subject to deletions, additions, or changes without notice. These items are not covered or under the control of CIMPAD, since changes in Government regulations and labor agreements cannot always be anticipated in advance. CIMPAD is not responsible for any changes initiated by the participant after departure to Angola.

### NOT INCLUDED:

- **Airfare:** Participants are responsible for air travel arrangements to and from Angola.
- **Hotel Accommodations:** Participants are responsible for making their hotel reservations at either the Intercontinental Luanda or the Protea Luanda hotels. Included shuttle service will only be provided to these hotels. Accommodations made elsewhere may impact your ability to use shuttle and transfer services provided.
- **Health and Immunizations:** We do not pay medical bills. Anti-Malaria prescriptions should be arranged before departure. For further recommendations on immunizations, we suggest contacting a personal physician or travel clinic at least 4 weeks before travel. Angola requires a Yellow Fever certificate of immunization. Health insurance and any emergency care during travel are the responsibility of the attendee.
- **Taxes:** Some airport departure or entry taxes are not included. If applicable, passengers must pay in cash on location.
- **Travel Documentation:** All travel documents are the responsibility of the attendee. A valid passport is required in all cases. U.S. citizens also need a visa when traveling to many different countries. Make sure to check country visa requirements before you travel if you are visiting multiple countries. Some additional vaccinations may be required.
- **Baggage:** Check with airlines directly for all legs of your air travel to confirm baggage restrictions and allowances.
- **Additional expenses:** Additional expenses such as excess baggage charges, baggage insurance, meals, or items of a personal nature.
